Nisos Yacht Charter is a well established British family owned and run business. We focus on providing premium Bareboat, Assisted Bareboat, Skippered Charters and Villa Holidays in the Ionian Sea, Greece. Our base is at the village of Perigiali, on the east coast of Lefkada (Lefkas) island in the centre of the Ionian Sea.

From here you are perfectly placed to either head north up to Corfu, Paxos and Anti Paxos or south to Meganissi, Ithica, Kalamos, Kastos and Kefalonia.



Our base is run by Laurie Campbell, who has over 25 years of charter fleet management experience in the Ionian. As soon as you arrive at our base you are in good hands. Laurie and his team are there to ensure that your holiday runs smoothly and are contactable at all times in case you need any assistance.

The Ionian is perfect for relaxed cruising holidays. With predictable winds, clear warm waters, flat seas and numerous bays and villages to stop at, it really is the perfect, safe idyllic sailing area.



Maximum sailing time

Nisos Yacht Charter is the only operator to give you every night away from base on your holiday. We will have you on board your yacht and away from base on the Sunday afternoon of arrival and we only request that you return to base on the Sunday morning of departure. Our base is located close to a large number of beautiful overnight stops giving you plenty of opportunity to really make the most of your precious holiday.

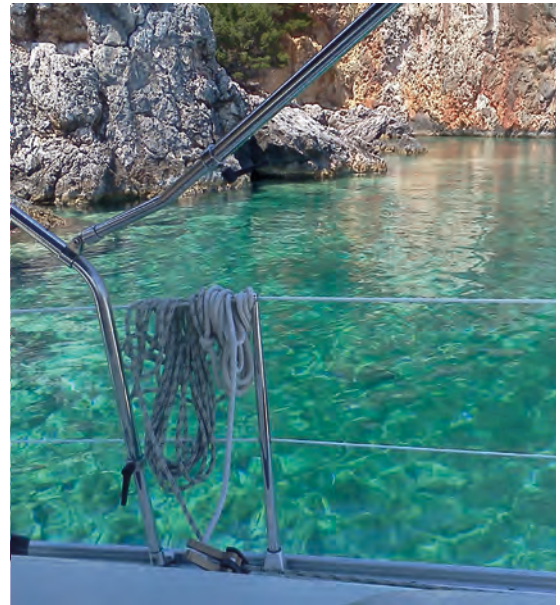
Bareboat Charters

Exploring the Ionian islands on your own yacht, with no restrictions on when and where you can go, is the ultimate way to spend your sailing holiday. This is what bareboat sailing is all about.

You pick up the yacht from our base, and after a thorough briefing on the safety aspects and operation of the yacht and a briefing on the sailing area, you are free to leave. The majority of our clients leave our base on the day of arrival.

You can keep in touch with us by VHF or mobile phone throughout the week if required, to get weather updates and itinerary ideas. At the end of the week you return the yacht to base on the morning of departure.

In a one or two week holiday you can explore the islands of Lefkas, Meganissi, Kefalonia, Ithica and Kalamos. If you wish to go further afield, Corfu and Paxos to the north are all achievable.



What if we need assistance?

If at any time during your trip you need assistance then we are on call 24 hours a day. We have a fast RIB (the ex Sidmouth inshore life boat) on standby, and can be with you very quickly.

What qualifications do I need to go bareboat?

In order to comply with Greek regulations, the skipper of the yacht must hold a relevant practical sailing qualification. This could be in the form of an RYA Day Skipper (practical), International Certificate of Competence ("ICC"), ASA 104 or an International Yacht Training ("IYT") skipper certificate.

We can help you obtain the necessary qualifications, so please do call to discuss how we can help if you have any doubts.

If you are a little rusty, or have an inexperienced crew we can provide a skipper for a day or two to help get your sea legs back. We want you to have a wonderful stress free holiday and will do all we can to ensure this happens.

Assisted Bareboat Flotilla

The Assisted Bareboat Flotilla programme was set up at the request of clients, who wanted the freedom offered by a bareboat charter, but with the safety net the flotillas provide. This programme runs from May through to September and is perfect for those taking their first steps away from the traditional flotillas or for those who prefer to have assistance in the evenings in finding mooring spaces.

How it works

We place a maximum of eight yachts into a mini flotilla group, with a lead boat and lead crew. There will be a set itinerary which will be in the South Ionian, and the lead crew will be at the pre-determined destination each evening to ensure that you get a safe berth for the night.

With a small number of yachts to look after, the lead crew can give you the time and attention which you deserve, and you are free to arrive at the destination when you like – so that you can stay out and enjoy the late afternoon/early evening winds.

When you are safely tied up, there are no organised group social activities at all, so you are free to do as you please. The skipper must have a practical sailing qualification such as RYA Day Skipper or an "ICC" to charter a yacht on the Assisted Bareboat Scheme.

The costs

The cost for participating on the Assisted Bareboat Scheme is only £350 per boat per week on top of the normal bareboat price, or £600 for two weeks

Skippered Charters

For those who want to learn to sail or just have someone do the hard work for them, then why not take one of our skippers on board with you?

Our skippers have lived and worked in the area for a number of years, and know all the places to go, so that you get the most out of the holiday.

If you want to learn to sail, then they will have you sailing the boat on your own within the week, with just the skipper keeping a watchful eye on proceedings.

The skipper will require their own berth on the boat and will sleep onboard. We realise that this is your holiday, and the skippers are very conscious that you have your own time together and try and factor in your desires and wishes as much as possible.

A typical day will include sailing to a new destination every evening, with a good lunch stop for snorkelling and swimming in beautiful bays. You will visit a different village every evening.

A skipper costs £950 per week. It is expected that they are included in your eating plans, and meals ashore paid for.



We can also supply a skipper and hostess for your holiday. The hostess will keep the yacht clean and make beds as well as preparing delicious home made breakfasts and lunch on board for you. Evening meals and can be prepared at additional cost.

The price for the skipper and hostess, inclusive of breakfast, lunch and soft drinks is £2,100 for the week (up to 6 guests).

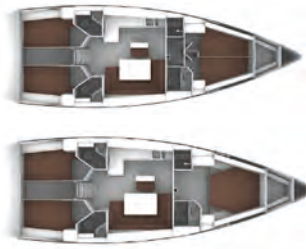

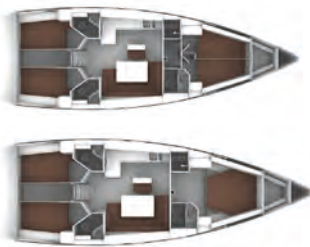

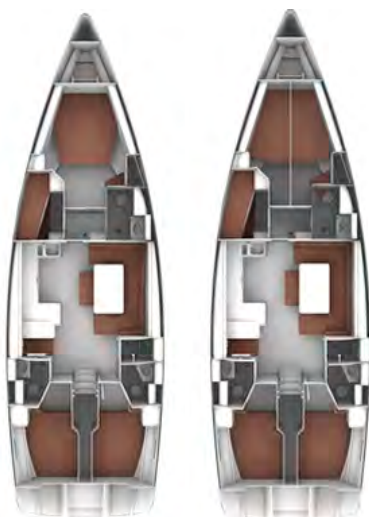

The Ionian Islands



The distances between the islands are relatively small so your time at sea can be as short or as long as you (and your crew) desire. On the following page you can see an example itinerary in the South Ionian. There are so many bays and villages to visit, so this suggestion really is just a starting point. We can devise a personal itinerary for you and suggest on the best lunch stop bays and tavernas to visit.



The Ionian Islands are one of the most popular areas to sail in the world. The cruising area stretches from Corfu in the north to Kefalonia in the south. In between we have the beautiful islands of Lefkada (where we are based), Meganissi, Ithica, Kalamos and Kastos.

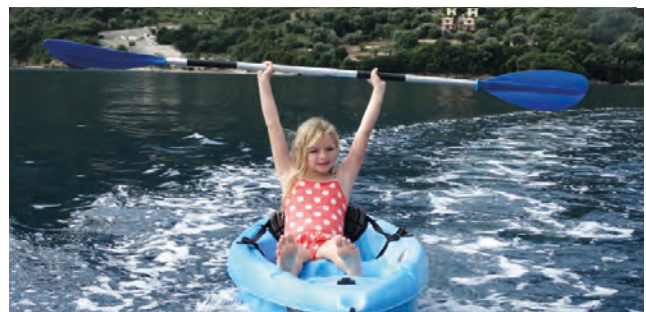
The islands are close to each other, which results in a protected sailing area, which means minimal sea swell and an extremely safe area for swimming in the inviting, crystal clear, warm waters.



What's the weather like?

Our season starts at the beginning of May and runs through to the end of October. In this period the weather is mostly very good, with air temperatures from 20 to 35 degrees and water temperatures from 18 to 30 degrees.

Winds are consistent throughout the season with a normal F3/4 in the afternoons. The Ionian region is not impacted by the very strong Meltemi winds, making it suitable for children and inexperienced crews.



Suggested Itinerary

This suggested one week itinerary starting from our base at Perigiali on Lefkas Island incorporates a mixture of overnight stops in villages and in bays, and is considered suitable for all levels of experience/ages.

Sunday: arrive at base and set sail for Vathi on Meganissi Island. 1 hr



Monday: head south to Sivota on Lefkas Island. 3 hrs



Tuesday: head south to Pollis Bay on Ithica. 4 hrs



Wednesday: Get in early to Fiskardo – beautiful village on Kefalonia. 3 hrs



Thursday: Head around the south of Ithica and up to the beautiful village of Kioni. 5 hrs



Friday: Head north back to Lefkas and anchor off in Desimmi Bay. 4 hrs



Saturday: Sail around the bottom of Meganissi and back up to Spartachori for your last night. 5 hrs

Flights and Transfers

Preveza is our local airport, just 35 minutes from our base at Perigiali on Lefkas. Flights into Preveza are from Gatwick, Heathrow, Manchester, Bristol and Birmingham. Flight prices vary considerably depending on date of travel. Current costs are from £180pp return in the low season to £400pp return in high season.

We arrange your transfer for you from Preveza Airport. This costs approximately Euros 10pp each way using the transfer mini coach or Euros 50 for your own taxi. Transfer costs are payable direct to the driver, and are subject to change.
